

<u>Design</u>

- In-House (Govt & AE) Staff vs. AE IDIQ Task Order
 - In-House Staff:
 - Projects important to develop/maintain design engineering competencies
 - Staff sized for steady-state program
 - AE IDIQ task orders for:
 - Unusual/complex projects
 - Compressed execution schedule
 - Capacity for workload surge
- Design-Build (DB) vs. Design-Bid-Build (DBB)
 - Design-Build (DB)
 - Lower Solicitation RFP cost (DB RFP development less expensive)
 - Low Complexity (DB suited for less complex admin/barracks, etc.)
 - Speed of execution; DB faster to construction award (expiring funds)
 - Design-Bid-Build (DBB)
 - Complex specialty projects
 - Mission BOD needs (DBB faster to BOD)
 - Non-Navy
 - NAVFAC will typically execute Supported Command's desired strategy

Acquisition Strategy (3/3)



Construction

- MACC Task Order is generally preferred method
 - Prequalified contractors
 - Faster than full and open
 - Competitive Award
- "East" \$249M Medium MACC solicited July 20
 - Q4 FY21 award with task orders \$4M to \$20M Small Business set-aside
- "West" \$249M Medium MACC solicited Aug 20
 - Q4 FY21 award with task orders \$4M to \$20M Small Business set-aside
- Large SE-wide \$900M MACC solicited Sep 20
 - Q4 FY21 or Q1 FY22 award with task orders \$20M to \$100M
- \$4.5M and under projects are generally solicited by individual PWD's



NAVFAC SE Contract Award Outlook



- \$263M in MILCON awarded across 11 projects in FY21
- \$116M in MILCON awards across 10 projects in FY22, \$604M across 5 projects in FY23
- \$444M in Special Project awarded across 6 projects in FY21, \$74M across 3 projects in FY22
- \$39M in Facility Support Contracts (FSC/BOS) to be awarded in FY21, \$52M in FY22, & \$16M in FY23
- A&E Contracts; 3 expire in FY22 \$90M, 1 expires in FY23 \$10M; 2 expire in FY24 \$40M; 6 expire in FY25 \$232M
- Multi-Award Construction Contracts (MACCs): Approximately \$732M in capacity across 5 existing contracts expire over next 3-years; Another \$1,947M in capacity across another 3 existing contracts will expire in FYs 26-28 – noteworthy, our burn rates on our MACCs are typically high
- Small Multi-Award Construction Contracts (mini-MACCs): \$180M in capacity expired in FY21 across 3-contracts; FY24 is your next shot – 2 contracts \$75M; FY25 – 1 contract - \$30M






