- FY 23 Total number of LMIR actions awarded: 63
- FY 24 Total number of LMIR actions awarded: 92

- **Completed solely by the Stewardship/Disaster Recovery LMIR BPA Team:**
- (All of these awards were completed while simultaneously building the LMIR BPA, growing the national contractor pool, and supporting other contracting groups using the LMIR BPA. During this time, we also built the LMIR BPA Website with the assistance of the FS Website Support Contractor)
- Total Award Amount Obligated since inception
- **FY 23: \$49,291,515.54**
- **FY 24: \$19,594,316.68**

- Cost Savings of LMIR BPA: In fiscal year 24, the IGE Total was \$29,644,887.67, however the actual awarded total amount was \$19,594,316.68. **That is a cost savings of \$10,080,570.99.**
- We also worked on 8 contracts that were ultimately cancelled by program in FY 24. The estimated contract award value of those projects totaled \$2.7 million.

- **Completed by contracting groups in the USDA Forest Service other than the LMIR BPA Team:**
- Total Award Amount (to date): \$ 8,100,006.50

- **Completed by federal contracting groups outside of the USDA Forest Service:**
- The BLM has awarded at least **\$3,042,920.22** and NPS has awarded at least **\$143,856.00** by utilizing the LMIR BPA. Federal Agencies using or requesting information regarding the LMIR BPA: BLM, NRCS, USFW, DOI, Federal Highways, National Park Service.

- **If you respond to the BPA, we will always let you know if we need more information or if you will be getting an award or not and the reason why. You will be notified via email.**
- **It is the contractor's responsibility to keep us updated on the best point of contact and email address.**
- **Evaluation Factors may change on each call order.**
- **Contractors must have active SAM account in order to receive award.**
- **Invoicing is done through the IPP.GOV system.**
- **We can do multiple award call orders**
